TO-GO ALCOHOL

Florida is the latest state to make to-go alcohol purchases permanently legal. Florida's Gov. Ron DeSantis signed <u>Senate Bill 148</u> into law which permanently allows restaurants to sell alcoholic beverages for to-go. All to-go alcohol must include a food purchased as well. The bill took effect July 1, 2021.

PAYMENT

If a customer leaves FISH RESTAURANT and takes both copies of the receipt (Signed copy or tip receipt) There will be a 15% service charge added to the bill.

CORKAGE FEE

If a customer would like to consume their own wines that we do not sell, there will be a corkage fee of \$25 for the first bottle, the second bottle will be a fee of \$35 dollars and the third bottle will be a fee of \$45 dollars. We will not except any bottle of wine to be brought in for consumption that we have on our wine list.

GRATUITY

Parties of six or more will have 20% gratuity added to the check. Special event parties will be charged 22% gratuity added to the check.
